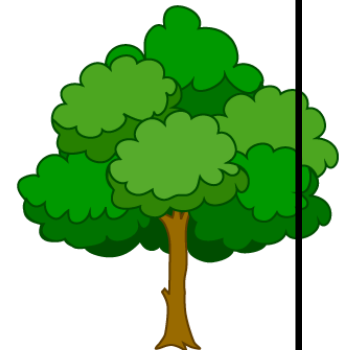
Parental Involvement

- To recognise common themes in traditional tales.
- To use traditional openings and endings in their writing.
- To be able to retell stories.
- To write stories about their own experiences.

English Basic Skills

- To include conjunctions for subordination - such as 'because'.
- To use 'and' to extend their sentences.
- To accurately use capital letters and full stops.

Maths



- Count in 2s, 5s and, 10s.
- Recognise place value in 2 digit numbers.
- Read and write numbers to 100 in numerals and words.
- Partition 2 digit numbers in different ways.
- Compare numbers using greater than, less than and equal to.
- Recognise addition and subtraction symbols.
- Become confident in addition and subtraction within 100.
- Have a firm understanding of different representations of numbers.
- Begin to multiply and divide.

Science

This term we are learning about living things and their habitats. We will learn all about the different life processes to classify a living thing and we will apply our knowledge to categorise living, dead or never alive. We will also look at habitats and how they sustain life.

Geography
